- 1 player must be a US citizen. If the 2nd player is not a citizen he or she must be a legal US resident with a valid Permanent Resident card (Form I-551/Green card) and able to travel abroad to the WC, if qualified.
- If you are a resident, proof of residency is required. You may photo copy your residency card and submit it with this form or show at check-in.
- All players must sign this form before they play. This form will also be available at check-in for you to sign.
- Teams are required to wear matching shirts of the same brand, style, and color to participate in this tournament.
